3. NO loitering AFTER THE TEEN CENTER CLOSES!
IF A TEEN DECIDES TO STAY AFTER THE TEEN CENTER CLOSES HE OR SHE MUST PURCHASE AN OPEN PLAY WRIST BAND!
4. NO Profanity, Offensive Language, Obscene Gestures, or Disorderly Conduct.
5. NO defying the authority of the staff.
6. NO stealing or accepting stolen property.
7. NO vandalism, graffiti or defacement of any part of the facility.
8. NO fighting or verbal abuse
9. NO Alcohol/Drugs/Controlled Substances/Drug Paraphernalia.
10. NO clothing advertising Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, Sexual Activity and Obscenity or Anti-Social behavior allowed.
11. NO weapons permitted anywhere on the premises.
12. NO Sexual Harassment

Teen Center Code of Conduct

The City of Rancho Cucamonga Community Services Department Staff is committed to providing a positive, safe, nurturing environment for every teen. We need commitment, cooperation, support, and open communication between staff, teens and parents to be successful.

The Teen Center Code of Conduct are the behavioral guidelines for ALL teens at the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and Homework Study Room as well as ALL trips and any other teen activities.

All teens are expected to follow and obey all program rules. Infractions of program rules such as the use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, possession of weapons, obscene acts, vulgarity or profanity, assault and battery, fighting, vandalism, graffiti or defacement of equipment and/or property, defiance of staff authority will not be tolerated.

Corrective disciplinary measures according to the severity of the infraction will be taken with any teen that violates any of the above program rules. Parents will be contacted. The Sheriff's Department will also be contacted depending on the severity of the infraction.

Please read and discuss with your teen the Teen Center Code of Conduct requirements. When you have done so, please sign attached form; indicating understanding of teen's responsibility and agreeing to uphold the standards set forth by the staff of the City of Rancho Cucamonga Community Services Department. The attached parent permission form must also be signed prior to participating in the Teen Center.

- **ID CARDS**

All teens are required to have a current pictured School ID or a Teen Center ID (available at the Teen Center) to participate in the Teen Center. Teens are required to present ID cards when signing in at the Teen Center and Homework Study Room, and when Checking Out Equipment. Lending or giving ID cards to others is prohibited. The replacement for a lost Teen Center ID card is \$1.00.

- **SIGN-IN AND OUT PROCEDURES**

All teen participating at the Teen Center are required to sign-in and out at the Teen Center desk each day they visit. Failing to follow procedures will result in a parent/guardian being contacted, and could result in a suspension from the Teen Center program.

- **ALCOHOL/DRUGS/CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES/DRUG PARAPHERNALIA**

A teen may not possess, sell, use or furnish or be under the influence of any alcoholic beverage, intoxicant or controlled substance. Consequences will include suspension and/or expulsion from the RC Family Sports Center Teen Center and Teen programs. The Sheriff's Department will be contacted.

- **WEAPONS**

A teen may not possess, sell, use or furnish any firearm, knife, explosive or dangerous object. A violation will result in expulsion from the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and Teen programs. The Sheriff's Department or Fire Marshall will be contacted.

- **SEXUAL HARRASSEMENT**

A teen engaging in sexual harassment will be suspended and could be expelled from the RC Family Sports Center/ Teen Center and Teen programs. Sexual harassment consists of unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal, visual or physical conduct of a sexual nature.

- **LANGUAGE**

The use of profanity or offensive language, obscene gestures, or disorderly conduct will result in a suspension.

- **FIGHTING**

A teen may not cause, or threaten to cause physical harm to another person. A teen involved in any form of intimidation, threats, incitement, hazing, or harassment, as well as, fighting will be suspended from the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and Teen programs. An assault could result in expulsion from the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and Teen programs.

- **VANDALISM**

Teens will be suspended from the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and Teen programs for causing damage to city personal property. This included defacing or destroying such property. Teens and parents will be responsible for the cost of repair or replacement of any city or personal property damages by vandalism. The Sheriff's Department will be contacted.

Teen Center Code of Conduct

- **GRAFFITI**

Any teen involved in any form of graffiti will be suspended and could result in expulsion from the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and Teen programs. Possession of spray cans, marking pens or markers, and paint pellets by teens is prohibited and may result in suspension. The use of these items to vandalize, or tag the RC Family Sports Center, Teen Center, or personal property will result in expulsion. The Sheriff's Department will be contacted. Teens and parents will be responsible for the cost of repair to any City or personal property caused by graffiti.

- **STEALING**

Any teens caught stealing City or personal property or knowingly accepts stolen property may be expelled from the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and all Teen programs. Teen and parent may be responsible to make full restitution. Extortion will result in the same consequences. The Sheriff's Department will be contacted.

- **DEFIANCE**

A teen will be suspended for willfully defying the authority of any staff. Consequences of infractions will result in suspension of the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and all Teen programs.

- **LASER POINTERS**

Laser pointer may cause physical harm/injury. Laser pointers are not permitted and will be confiscated by staff. A repeat violation may result in suspension from the RC Family Sports Center/Teen Center and Teen programs.

- **DRESS GUIDELINES**

1. Shoes must be worn at all times. Only non-marked soles allowed in gym and racquetball courts.
2. Clothing that advertises and/or promotes alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and sexual activity or suggest obscenity or anti social behavior is not allowed. Derogatory messages or messages that disparages any individual or group of individuals are not allowed.
3. Any jewelry, or clothing that could be a safety hazard to one's self or others are not allowed.

- **COMPUTERS AND INTERNET ACCESS**

A teen that inappropriately interferes with or disrupts other users, services or equipment will be suspended from the Homework Study Room. Disruptions included, but are not limited to, distribution of unsolicited advertising, harassment, propagation of computer viruses, or use of the network to make unauthorized entry to any machine.

Teens using the Internet for any illegal activity, or place any text, data, graphic images, messages, communications, files or material related to any illegal activity on the Internet will result in expulsion from the program the RC Family Sports Center. The Sheriff's Department will be contacted.

- **MOVIES**

Movies rated up to PG 13 may be shown at the Teen Center. Staff will review movies prior to showing them to the teens. If you have an objection to your teen watching PG 13 rated movies please advise staff.

All forms are required for your teen to continue participating at the Teen Center. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
